

COVID Guidelines

- All clients must wear a face covering *at all times*. This includes while using a cage or on the infield.
- Please remain home if you are feeling sick, have a fever, have been in contact with someone that tested positive with COVID-19, or traveled to an area that has a high rate of positive COVID-19 cases.
- All clients must remain 6 feet from each other when in the facility and the Pro Shop.
- Parents, siblings, and friends are not allowed in the facility as spectators. This will reduce the number of people in the facility at any given time.
- No more than 5 clients at a time are allowed in the Pro Shop.
- SPP employees will sanitize the facility and common areas daily, including at the start and end of each shift, and every 2 hours while on shift.
- There are hand sanitizing stations throughout the facility that we encourage everyone to use frequently.
- Equipment that SPP makes available for their clients, such as helmets, balls, and bats should be used sparingly by our clients. We have moved these items to the Pro Shop to ensure they are properly sanitized before and after each use. See Pro Shop staff to obtain equipment.
- SPP discourages hand to hand contact such as handshakes, high-fives, and fist bumps.
- All clients should avoid congregating in groups.
- The water fountain will not be accessible at this time. Please be sure to bring enough water with you or you may purchase bottles of water in the Pro Shop.
- Infield Guidelines:
 - Players must remain in the infield area and adhere to social distancing markers in the bench area while waiting for their turn on the field. A face covering must be worn <u>at all times</u> while on or off the field.
 - Coaches & Players must wear a face covering at all time.
 - Teams should come to the facility just a few minutes prior to the start of their reservation and leave immediately afterwards. The coach should enter the facility prior to any players entering to ensure that the field is clear from any previous reservations.
- Cage Guidelines:
 - Teams can have no more than 6 players in the facility at one time while utilizing the cages unless a team has a 2-hour time slot where the Infield is the hour before the cages.
 - Players must wait in the designated boxes outside of each cage while waiting for their turn in the cage. A face covering must be worn <u>at all times</u> while in or out of the cage.
 - Coaches & Players must wear a face covering at all times.
 - Teams should come to the facility just a few minutes prior to the start of their reservation and leave immediately afterwards and should refrain from congregating.

All clients are requested to follow these guidelines, or they may be asked to leave the facility.
